PLAY MASTER (IRE) (2001 c. by Second Empire (IRE)), **won** three races and £15,565 on the flat and placed five times.

DEADSHOT KEEN (IRE) (2004 c. by Invincible Spirit (IRE)), **won** two races, £27,280: **won** one race at two years and £6,016 and placed three times; also **won** one race at three years, 2007 and £21,264 in U.S.A. and placed twice.
