UISCE TINE (IRE), unraced.

Dam of 1 runner, 1 previous foal:

Moylough Princess (IRE) (2006 f. by Medecis (GB)), placed once at two years, 2008.

#### 2nd Dam

ISCA (GB), unplaced on the flat at two and three years.

Dam of **six winners**, 7 runners, 9 living foals:

**SONDA (IRE)**, **won** six races at two and three years and £77,103 in Italy including Premio Dormello, Milan, **Gr.3** and Premio Torricola, Rome, **L.** and placed three times including second in Premio Royal Mares Limited Handicap, Turin, **L.** and third in Premio Novella - Trofeo Tattersalls, Milan, **L.**; dam of **four winners**:

FAGIUDIZI (GB), **winner** in Italy.

FARABUTT (GB), **winner** in Italy.

OCTOBER SONG (IRE), **winner** in Italy to 2008.

FURMENTUN (GB), **winner** in Italy to 2008.

TYPE ONE (IRE), **won** six races at three, five and six years, £36,983, placed nine times.

MILLERS WEIR (IRE), **won** four races at five to seven years and placed seventeen times.

SINCRONY (IRE), **won** four races at two and three years and £12,642 in Italy; broodmare.

THOMAS MALORY (IRE), **won** two races at two and three years, 2008, placed six times.

STORMBURST (IRE), **won** one race at three years, 2007 and £5,281 and placed six times.

#### 3rd Dam

SARSINA, ran three times on the flat at two years.

Dam of **two winners**, 3 runners, 3 foals:

CAMICIA (GB), **won** three races, £11,041: **won** one race, placed three times; also **won** two races at four years in Australia and placed twice; dam of **winners** including:

**Cashkalani (AUS)**, **winner**, second in Feltex Queen Adelaide Stakes, Victoria, **L.**

OSTIA (GB), **won** two races at three years and £4,775 in Germany and placed once.

#### 4th Dam

SANCTA, **won** three races at three years, £11,082 and placed three times, from only 8 starts.

Dam of **eight winners**:

**Wolsey (USA)**, **won** five races and £49,286 and placed four times including second in Alycidon Glorious Stakes, Goodwood, **L.**; also placed twice in U.S.A. including second in Bay Meadows Derby, Bay Meadows, **Gr.3**.

**Carmelite House (USA)**, **won** three races and £19,575; also placed once in France, fourth in Prix Eugene Adam, Saint-Cloud, **Gr.2**; sire.

WELL BELOVED (GB), **won** three races at three years, £21,120 and placed six times; sire.

KIRK (GB), **won** one race at three years, placed twice; dam of **two winners** including:

**Natalie Jane (IRE)**, **winner**, placed second in EBF Chalice Stakes, Newbury, **L.**, third in Lancashire Oaks, Haydock Park, **Gr.2** and Zetland Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**

The next dam **SOFT ANGELS**, Champion 2-y-o filly in England in 1965, **won** two races at two years including Royal Lodge Stakes, Ascot and placed once; Own sister to SUGAR APPLE.

Dam of **two winners**:

Doubly Sure, placed once at three years; dam of **six winners** including:

**KRIS**, Champion 3yr old miler in England in 1979, Champion older miler in Europe in 1980, **won** Sussex Stks, **Gr.1**, second in 2000 Guineas Stks, **Gr.1**; champion sire.

**RUDIMENTARY (USA)**, **won** Forte Mile, Sandown Park, **Gr.2**, placed second in Premio Vittorio di Capua, Milan, **Gr.1**; sire.

**DIESIS**, Champion 2yr old in Europe in 1982, **won** three races at two years and £89,796 including William Hill Dewhurst Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**; a leading sire.
