

# Vendor Sale Requirements

## *(Appendix 3)*

This page is referred to in the DBS Conditions of Sale. Passports must be lodged in the Auctioneers' Office prior to sales per Condition of Sale 2.4

**All Vendors must leave a contact telephone number at the Stable Office to ensure that they are contactable in case of emergency.**

---

**Foals:** Passport. Flu vaccinations not mandatory.

**Yearlings:** Passport. Flu vaccinations must be up-to-date (see below).

**Breeze-Ups:** Passport. Flu vaccinations must be up-to-date (see below).

**Horses-in-Training (Aged two years and upwards):** Passport. Flu vaccinations must be up-to-date (see below).

**Three & Four Year Stores (Spring and NH Breeze-Up Sales only):** Passport. Flu vaccination must be up-to-date (see below).

**Mares in Foal:** Broodmare Passport, Flu vaccinations should be up-to-date (see below). Pregnancy certificate and EVA Certificate dated within 28 days of the sale, Health certificate stating that for 15 days prior to the Sale the mare has not been in contact with equines suffering from contagious diseases, Covering Certificate are all mandatory.

**Barren Mares:** Broodmare Passport, Flu vaccinations should be up-to-date (see below). Contagious equine metritis-free certificate stating that a negative clitoral swab (fossa and sinuses) has been obtained (the standard Horserace Betting Levy Board certificate should be used as this also refers to other venereal diseases), EVA Certificate dated within 28 days of the Sale, Health certificate stating that for 15 days prior to the Sale the mare has not been in contact with equines suffering from contagious diseases, Covering Certificate are all mandatory.

**Potential Broodmares:** Passport. Flu vaccinations must be up-to-date (see below). Health certificate stating that

for 15 days prior to the Sale the mare has not been in contact with equines suffering from contagious diseases, Breeding and EVA Certificates dated within 28 days of the sales are recommended.

**Broodmares Covered in a Previous Season:** Same documents as Barren Mares except Covering Certificate is not required.

**Flu Vaccinations (Condition of Sale 2.5):** Two primary injections to be given not less than twenty-one and not more than ninety-two days apart. A booster injection should be given not less than one hundred and fifty and not more than two hundred and fifteen days apart. Thereafter, one injection should be given annually.

**Headcollars (Condition of Sale 14.3):** It is a Condition of Sale that all horses must wear a headcollar at all times in the Sales Complex (Condition 14.3). This is in the interests of Health & Safety and at the request of several organisations including the Racehorse Transporters' Association. To prevent possible injury to horse and handler when a lot is removed from its box. DBS have arranged for Gibson Saddlers to have a quantity of inexpensive headcollars for this purpose. Where the Vendor is found to have left the lot without a headcollar after the sale, DBS will supply a headcollar at the Vendor's expense.

**Microchips (Condition of Sale 2.4(b)):** All Lots born in UK or Ireland after 2000 should have been microchipped at birth. Please note that all horses must be microchipped when arriving at the Sales Complex. This may be particularly relevant to those foaled outside UK or Ireland.

**French Import/Export (Condition of Sale 2.6):** It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure all Import/Export documents have been compiled prior to the sale or the lot must be withdrawn. DBS will not pay the sales proceeds to the vendor until the appropriate documentations has been delivered to the purchaser.

These requirements may be waived at the absolute discretion of DBS.
