Conditions of Sale

Vendors attention is drawn to the DBS Conditions of Sale which can be viewed online at www.goffsdbs.com/downloads. Please contact DBS if you require a printed copy.

Fees and Commission

Fees and Commission are payable in accordance with Condition of Sale 2.12.

Reserves

Please note that Vendors must lodge reserves in writing in the Auctioneers Office prior to the Sale on each occasion. Reserve forms are available in the Auctioneers Office and a separate form should be completed for each Lot. Condition 2.1 states the reserves must be received in writing prior to the Lot being offered otherwise the Lot will be offered without reserve.

Payment

Payment of sales proceeds will be made in accordance with the Conditions of Sale and will be effected only when DBS have received written instructions in accordance with Condition 2.10 and subject to Condition 2.8 and 2.9.

TBA Sales Levy

Vendors attention is drawn to Condition 2.11. DBS will make the appropriate deduction from the sales proceeds of British Vendors and inform the TBA of the Vendors who have paid the levy, unless written notification not to do so has been received by DBS within 28 days from the last day of the Sale.

Catalogue Descriptions and Pedigrees

The details of all Lots contained in the catalogue are provided by the Vendor who is solely responsible for their contents and accuracy. Each entry will follow the DBS Catalogue Style (Appendix 2). DBS accept no liability for catalogue descriptions, pedigrees or performances, which are prepared for them by Weatherbys Bloodstock Services and the content or accuracy of any other warranty representation or statement made by the Vendor in relation to any Lot. A copy of the catalogue will be sent to the person entering the horse. It is the Vendor's responsibility to check the details of each Lot and any errors should be notified to DBS immediately otherwise it will be assumed that the details are confirmed by the Vendor as correct. Failure to notify DBS may prevent any error being corrected and being publicised before the Sale.

Basis of Sale

Vendors must complete this section of the entry form in accordance with Condition 4, using one of the following options, otherwise the Lot will be catalogued 'Sold as he/she stands' (unless all Lots in a particular sale are sold in a specific manner)

- **Sold as he/she stands.** The horse is sold without a veterinary certificate. This is a common way of selling Horses in Training.
- **Sold with a Veterinary Certificate.** The horse is sold with a veterinary certificate, signed by an independent veterinary surgeon, dated within 28 days of the Sale and lodged in the Auctioneers Office to be read out by DBS at the Sale. The Purchaser may request that the Lot be given a full clinical examination by the DBS Veterinary Panel after the fall of the hammer. This condition can be used to sell Horses in Training.
- **Sold subject to re-examination.** The Lot is sold without a veterinary certificate but the Purchaser may request that the horse be given a full clinical examination by the DBS Veterinary Panel after the fall of the hammer. If the horse fails this examination, the Purchaser has the option of cancelling the Sale. Horses In Training can be offered in this way.
- **Sold subject to re-examination of Wind Only.** The horse is sold without a veterinary certificate and the Purchaser may request that the Lot is lunged for his/her wind by the DBS Veterinary Panel after the fall of the hammer. The Purchaser has the option of cancelling the Sale if the horse fails this examination. All Lots at the Breeze-Up Sales, Premier Sales, St. Leger Festival Sales and October Yearling Sales are sold in this way. Horses In Training can also be offered in this way.
- **Sold with a pre-sales veterinary certificate** (specific sales only). The horse will be examined by the DBS Veterinary Panel prior to Sale and the certificate will be read out at the time of Sale. All horses in the Spring Store Sales and the NH Breeze-Up Sales are sold in this way and many of the Horses in Training sold at the Newbury Sales will also be offered in this way.
- **Sold subject to re-examination of pregnancy only** (specific sales only). The Vendor must lodge all the required certificates (see Appendix 3) with DBS and the Purchaser may request that the Lot is examined for pregnancy by the DBS Veterinary Panel after the fall of hammer. If the horse fails this examination, the Purchaser has the option of cancelling the Sale. In-foal broodmares must be sold in this way.
- **With a breeding certificate** (specific sales only). The Lot is sold with a breeding certificate and the Purchaser may request that the Lot is re-examined by the DBS Veterinary Panel against this certificate after the fall of the hammer. If the horse fails the examination, the Purchasers have the option of cancelling the Sale. Potential broodmares may be sold in this way.

The above is a summary only and Vendors' attention is directed to the Conditions of Sale (Condition 4) for full clarification of the options available and the specifics of each Condition.

Description and Health

The Vendor is reminded to disclose any vices, unsoundness, etc. referred to in Condition of Sale 12 at the time of entry.

Vendors Sale Requirements

Vendors attention is drawn to the documentation required for each Lot as required in the Conditions of Sale and stated in each Sales catalogue.

Headcollars

As per Condition of Sale 14.3, all horses in the Sales Complex must wear a headcollar at all times. In order to prevent possible injury to horse and handler when the Lot is removed from its box, Vendors should ensure that headcollars are left on each Lot after they are sold.
